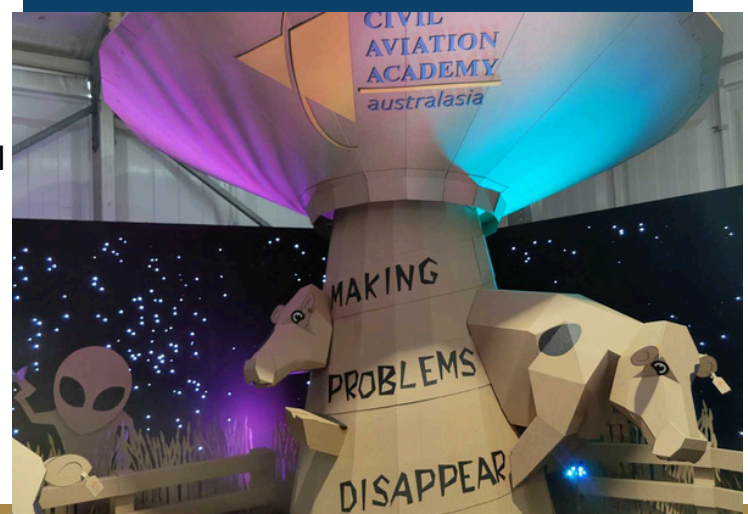

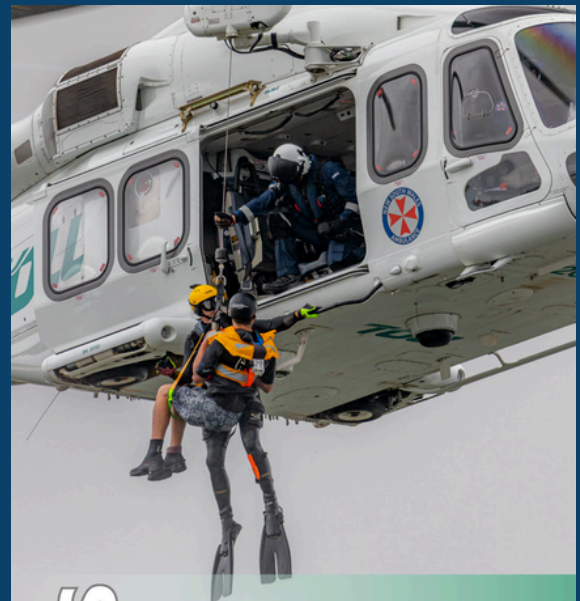
Upcoming CASA Deadlines

Part 133 (rotorcraft), Part 135 (smaller aeroplane) and certain Part 138 (aerial work) operators are required to implement your training and checking systems by 28 February 2025.

The 2024 deadlines for rotorcraft performance operations will be announced soon.

Understanding the differences in the shipping of infectious substances

Shipping biological materials such as infectious substances, biological substances, and patient specimens by air requires strict adherence to regulations to ensure safety and compliance. Infectious substances are classified into Category A or B, depending on the severity of the risk they pose, and require the highest level of packaging precautions under IATA guidelines. Biological substances, derived from living organisms, and patient specimens, collected for testing or diagnosis, have specific packaging and handling requirements based on their risk levels. All shippers of these materials must undergo CASA-approved training every two years to stay updated on safety protocols. Understanding these distinctions and following appropriate guidelines is essential for safe air transport and public health protection.
